

## THE MASTERS LODGE

The Masters Lodge is the smallest luxury lodge in New Zealand. Positioned atop Bluff Hill in the Art Deco city of Napier with spectacular views over the South Pacific Ocean, Cape Kidnappers and the city of Napier, the lodge offers a living room and cocktail lounge, formal dining room, solarium, drawing room, shady verandahs, beautifully maintained flower gardens, off-street parking, and much, much more!

The lodge has only 2 guest suites each with ensuite bath. Each suite overlooks Cape Kidnappers, the city of Napier and the South Pacific Ocean. Dinners are prepared by their renowned chef and are complemented by rare local wines from the extensive wine cellar. The highlight for wine enthusiasts staying at the lodge is the dinner with the wine maker. For the Art Deco enthusiasts, an Art Deco Dinner includes a private tour of the Art Deco city in a vintage car, cocktails and a hosted dinner at the lodge. Or, join the chef in The Master's Kitchen for a personal culinary class where you will learn to prepare the evening's culinary delights.

The lodge is in the heart of Hawke's Bay wine country and nearby world-ranked Cape Kidnappers golf course. The beach, shops, restaurants, museums and central business district are all within a 10 minute walk of the lodge.
