

## BAYVIEW CHATEAU TONGARIRO

Nestled on the snow-capped slopes of Mt Ruapehu, Bayview Chateau Tongariro places you in the midst of the Dual World Heritage Tongariro National Park.

Built in 1929, Bayview Chateau Tongariro is one of New Zealand's most historic hotels and national icons with unsurpassed views of the three magnificent mountains Ruapehu, Tongariro and Ngauruhoe.

Renowned for its classical elegance, it has played host to many international and domestic visitors over its 77 year history. Bayview Chateau Tongariro is a ski resort in the winter and a base for walking and trekking in the summer. The famous Tongariro Crossing is still a standout one-day trek. Both Lake Taupo and the Whanganui River are only 30 minutes away.

Bayview Chateau Tongariro has 106 well appointed rooms, all fully equipped and facilities include a 9-hole golf course, fitness centre, indoor heated plunge pool, tennis courts, conference facilities and in-house masseuse.



### SUGGESTED ITINERARY INCLUDING THE BAYVIEW CHATEAU TONGARIRO:

- DAY 1: Drive from Rotorua or Taupo to the Tongariro National Park  
2 nights in a Bayview Chateau Tongariro Premium Mountain View Room  
Dinner and breakfast daily in the Ruapehu Restaurant
- DAY 2: Relax at the hotel or take one of the many walking track options, including the famous and scenic Tongariro Crossing
- DAY 3: Continue south to Palliser Bay, east of Wellington
