

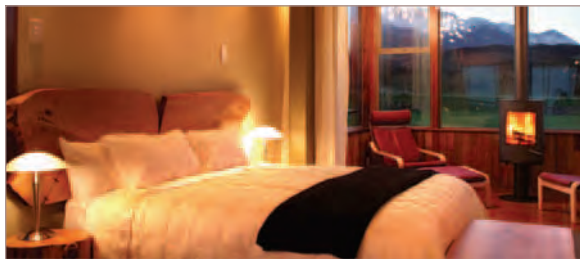
HAPUKU LODGE

Hapuku Lodge nestles between the dramatic Kaikoura mountains and the surf-washed Pacific coastline, an inspiring environment, complemented through the design of this contemporary lodge and its distinctive Tree Houses.

You'll find that Hapuku's unique Tree Houses are nestled in the branches of a manuka grove, complement the spectacular surrounds. A unique accommodation experience of sleeping amongst the branches is matched with the luxury of the custom-crafted and ultra-comfy king bed, large spa bath and efficient Danish log-burning fireplace. Wide-screen televisions, Bose and iPod stereo systems, rain-fountain showers and heated floors complete the high-level (excuse the pun!) of guest comfort. With stunning mountain and sea views, the individual Tree Houses are named after the native birds which have quickly adjusted to their new neighbours in the trees.

Lodge rooms offer the same custom designed handcrafted furniture, one of the most comfortable beds you'll find anywhere, stunning scenery through European tilt-swung windows. The Olive House apartment allows 360 degree views of mountains, sea, olive orchard, and grazing deer, a separate bedroom with king sized bed and spa bath, a full kitchen, laundry, open fireplace, and twin balconies.

Hapuku Lodge is created by a family of designers seeking to provide a restful experience in this most beautiful of locations. Naturally, the dining at the lodge is based on fresh supplies of seafood, venison, organic and local produce matched with South Island wines.

- 2 nights in a Tree House with views of the Pacific coastline, Seaward Kaikoura mountain ranges, surrounding deer farm and olive orchard. Each Tree House includes a large spa bath, fireplace, rain-fountain shower, unique handcrafted furnishings and the lodge's great sleeping king beds
- 3 course dinner included at the lodge with breakfast daily
- Morning Kaikoura Whale Watch Cruise
- Maori Cultural Tour, hiking and short walks, or drive to the ocean surf of Mangamaunu Bay
- Wine tasting at Kaikoura Winery, arguably New Zealand's most scenic winery
