The inviting central living area of the lodge incorporates a spacious lounge, library, bar and communal dining table, while the games room, guest office and secluded spa provide private areas to relax.

Guests of Whare Kea are able to enjoy an experience unique to New Zealand - a high alpine hosted stay at Whare Kea Chalet - access by helicopter only and luxury where you would least expect to find it.

- From the lodge make your way to the Chalet by helicopter. Enjoy a guided alpine walk followed by a gourmet picnic surrounded by the vista of high rocky mountains, glaciers, residual snow fields and alpine meadows
- Return to the lodge for one more night before continuing your New Zealand journey
