

KAURI CLIFFS

Set on 6,500 acres near Matauri Bay, Northland, The Lodge at Kauri Cliffs affords spectacular 180 degree views of the Pacific Ocean and overlooks the championship golf course. The beautiful panoramic view encompasses Cape Brett, the famous Hole in the Rock and the Cavalli Islands.

The main lodge hosts a spacious living room, two private day rooms, computer room and a beautiful dining room with outdoor deck overlooking the Pacific Ocean. A new spa facility is set in the forest nearby.

Eleven outlying luxury guest cottages, each with two guest suites, provide accommodation at Kauri Cliffs. The cottages are nestled on the edge of native forest overlooking the ocean and golf course and have been designed to offer the same stunning 180 degree vista as the main lodge from the private room verandahs.

Enjoy a walk to one of Kauri Cliffs' three private beaches, or picnic at the waterfall. Kauri Cliffs has something to offer everybody.
