

CORAL PRINCESS CRUISES

Launched in 2005, Oceanic Discoverer is the new benchmark standard for luxury expedition cruising in the Australasia Pacific region. The state-of-the-art Oceanic Discoverer is the grand vision of Coral Princess Cruises, pioneers and acknowledged leaders in adventure and expedition cruises.

Carrying just 72 guests, the ship is large enough to provide all the comfort and facilities of larger cruise ships, yet small enough to enable access to reef and island sites. Inflatable zodiacs and our purpose-built excursion vessel Xplorer convey passengers on daily explorations.

Coral Princess Cruises has a range of new five-night voyages between Auckland and Paihia with departures in December and January. The voyage will visit Tiri Tiri, one of only two scientific reserves in New Zealand, the historic Kawau Island, Port Fitzroy, Mokohinau, Poor Knights Islands, Whangamumu, Whangaroa Harbour and the Bay of Islands, before disembarking in Paihia. Guests have the chance to observe and photograph rare native birds and wildlife, enjoy guided walks and lectures with expert naturalists and the expedition leader, and explore New Zealand's secret alcoves.

For those with more time, Coral Princess Cruises also operate 12-night itineraries, cruising the dramatic coastline of both the North and South Islands of New Zealand. Itineraries operate January to March between Auckland and Milford Sound.
