Visitors can enjoy sporting venues, parklands, and scenic river walks. Brisbane's mild climate invites outdoor exploration in popular spots like South Bank Parklands and Queen Street Shopping Mall. Many locations across the city hold cultural, spiritual, and historical significance to Aboriginal communities, reflecting the ongoing connection of First Nations peoples to the land. Brisbane provides a rich blend of modern urban life and living Indigenous heritage.
